



November 17, 2025

The Municipal Utility Board met in a Regular Session at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, November 17, 2025, with Chairman Harris presiding. The agenda was posted outside in the Pryor City Hall Bulletin Case at 12 North Rowe Street. Members present were: Mr. Garry Harris, Dr. Ken Rains, Ms. Lorri Mitchell, Dr. Art Sixkiller, and Mr. Mark Roberts.

Mr. Kurt Schultz with Courtside Benefits Group was in attendance.

A motion was made by Dr. Rains and seconded by Mr. Roberts to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting held on November 10, 2025. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Rains, Mitchell, Sixkiller, Harris, and Roberts; Nay - none

The Board recognized Mr. Jared Crisp, who presented the claims for approval.

A motion was made by Dr. Sixkiller and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to approve Claims #0536 - #0591 totaling \$505,574.69 for payment. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Roberts, Sixkiller, Mitchell, Rains, and Harris; Nay – none

Honorable Mayor Doyle was recognized and mentioned that Bluepeak Fiber will be giving a presentation at the City Council Meeting on Tuesday, November 18th, 2025.

The Board recognized Mr. Kurt Schultz who discussed the proposed summaries of the Municipal Utility Board Employee Benefits effective January 1, 2026.

Mr. Jared Crisp presented a spreadsheet outlining the proposed options for Group Health Plans for CY 2026. He compared the price-increase quote from BlueCross BlueShield of Oklahoma with similar quotes from United Healthcare and Chamber Care. He expressed concern regarding ongoing premium increases and noted that he completed due diligence by requesting each employee to complete a questionnaire for potential eligibility for more favorable rates through Chamber Care (Aetna Network).

After careful review and comparison of all quotes, Mr. Crisp recommended that the Board approve renewal with the United Healthcare Base Plan and the optional Buy-Up Plan for CY 2026, along with the proposed schedule of employee payroll deductions. (See attached.)

He also reported that the Group Dental Plan with Delta Dental of Oklahoma will have no premium increase and no coverage changes for the upcoming year. The Vision Plan and AFLAC Plan will continue as voluntary participation plans with no MUB contribution toward premiums. AFLAC will have no changes or premium increases, and the Vision Plan will have no coverage changes and will include a slight reduction in monthly premiums. The Term Life coverage with Mutual of Omaha and the Long-Term Disability Plan with Dearborn Life Insurance Company will also renew with no premium increases.

A motion was made by Ms. Mitchell and seconded by Dr. Rains to renew the following:

- United Healthcare PPO Base Plan and optional Buy-Up PPO Plan for CY2026, with the proposed schedule of employee payroll deductions. *(See attached)*
- Delta Dental of Oklahoma PPO – Group #: 0010362
- VSP Vision Care - Policy # 30078209

- Term Life Plans (Mutual of Omaha)–Group ID G000B7T4
- Long-Term Disability Plan (Dearborn)– Group # FMS4233

Mr. Jared Crisp reported that the lugs for the Wastewater Treatment Plant generator have arrived, and the generator's startup is scheduled for December 2–3, 2025. He also noted that one of the pumps at the South Lift Station has failed and is currently being rebuilt.

Mr. Travis Willis reported that MUB received reimbursement from its General Liability Auto Insurance Company (OMAG) for the recent theft of Truck #1A. He is obtaining state contract pricing for new and used vehicles comparable to Truck #1A, which will be presented at a future meeting. He also stated that C&H Sales and Services completed the annual transformer oil testing at the substations, with excellent results.

A written Department Foreman's Report was presented with no additional comments.

There was no Unfinished Business or New Business to discuss.

Mr. Ben Sherrer had no report.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to adjourn at 7:16 p.m. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Roberts, Mitchell, Rains, Sixkiller, and Harris; Nay – none
