

## October 21, 2024

The Municipal Utility Board met in a Regular Session at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, October 21, 2024, with Chairman Harris presiding. The agenda was posted outside in the Pryor City Hall Bulletin Case at 12 North Rowe Street. Members present were: Mr. Garry Harris, Dr. Ken Rains, Ms. Lorri Mitchell, Dr. Art Sixkiller and Mr. Mark Roberts.

Guest attending were the Honorable Mayor Zach Doyle, Ms. Bridgette Nichols, and Mrs. Jennifer Adams.

A motion was made by Dr. Rains and seconded by Mr. Roberts to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting held October 7, 2024. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Rains, Roberts, Sixkiller, Mitchell, and Harris Nay – none

The Board recognized Mr. Jared Crisp who presented the claims for approval.

A motion was made by Dr. Sixkiller and seconded by Dr. Rains to approve Claims #0407 - #0465 totaling \$1,171,227.35 for payment. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Sixkiller, Rains, Mitchell, Roberts, and Harris Nay – none

The Board recognized the Honorable Mayor Doyle who reported the City of Pryor Creek Economic Development Trust Authority recovered the 44<sup>th</sup> Annual Bluegrass & Chili Festival initial investment plus a small profit and the sales tax disbursement to the City of Pryor for September 2024 was record breaking. He also reported the team members had already started discussions in the hope of hosting the 45<sup>th</sup> Annual Bluegrass & Chili Festival in Pryor, Oklahoma on a date which would better coordinate with other community and county activities.

The Board recognized Mr. Jared Crisp who reported the Legal Publication to Bid for the removal of sludge at the 9<sup>th</sup> Street Lift Station flow equalization basin (FEB) and land application has been processed. Bids will be received until 2:00 p.m. on November 5, 2024; and then publicly opened and read aloud in the Pryor Municipal Utility Board Room, 12 North Rowe, Suite A, Pryor, Oklahoma.

Mr. Jared Crisp reported the design had begun on the NIPAK Lift Station Improvement Project which includes replacing the pumps, rails, and above ground controls to make it SCADA ready for communication between the Lift Station and mobile devices.

Mr. Jared Crisp reported he was released to return to work full-time with an order for physical therapy until he reaches maximum flexibility on his knee replacement.

Mr. Jared Crisp reported the Municipal Utility Board and Grand River Dam Authority will be co-hosting the 2025 MESO Lineworker Rodeo. He and Mr. Willis are advocating to schedule the rodeo during Public Power Week at the Mayes County Fairgrounds and securing a block of rooms at a hotel located inside the city limits of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma.

The Board recognized Mr. Travis Willis who expressed gratitude for allowing him and the AMI Supervisory team to attend the informative Xylem Reach Conference in Atlanta, Georgia on October 13-16, 2024.

Mr. Travis Willis discussed three (3) quotes received for a concrete pad and reported the project was awarded to Clint Goodson Concrete Construction of Claremore, Oklahoma at a cost less than \$10,000.00.

The Board recognized Mrs. Teri Hill who reported on the GRDA Wholesale Customer Meeting she attended on October 16, 2024. The two keynote speakers represented the Large Public Power Council (LPPC) who advocate in Washington DC for energy availability, affordability, stability, and environmentally friendly. Their energy rates and infrastructure were astronomically much higher than fly over state rates like we have in Oklahoma. (John Di Stasio, President, LPPC lived in California and Tom Falcone, President-Elect, LPPC lived in Long Island, New York.)

A written Department Foreman's Report was presented with no additional comments.

The Board recognized Mr. Jared Crisp who discussed and recommended the Board allow him and Mr. Travis Willis to attend the 2024 Municipal Electric Systems of Oklahoma (MESO) Fall Conference at the Grand Casino Convention Center, Shawnee, Oklahoma on November 6-7, 2024

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to allow him and Mr. Travis Willis to attend the 2024 Municipal Electric Systems of Oklahoma (MESO) Fall Conference at the Grand Casino Convention Center, Shawnee, Oklahoma on November 6-7, 2024, at a cost not to exceed \$1,000.00.
