

JUNE 30, 2017

The Municipal Utility Board met in Regular Session at 5:00PM on Friday, 30 June 2017 with Chairman Harris presiding. The agenda was posted in the outside Pryor City Hall Bulletin Case at 12 North Rowe Street. Members present were: Mr. Harris, Dr. Lindsey, Dr. Sixkiller, Ms. Mitchell, and Mr. Roberts.

A motion was made by Dr. Lindsey and seconded by Mr. Roberts to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting held 19 June 2017. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Lindsey, Roberts, Mitchell, Sixkiller and Harris Nay – none

A motion was made by Dr. Sixkiller and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to approve Claims #1324 - 1376 totaling \$264,075.55 for payment. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Sixkiller, Mitchell, Roberts, Lindsey, and Harris Nay – none

A motion was made by Dr. Sixkiller and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to approve the Claims and Contracts Pending List ending 30 June 2017 in the amount of \$85,679.56. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Sixkiller, Mitchell, Lindsey, Roberts, and Harris Nay – none

The Board recognized Mr. Gary Pruett who discussed and recommended the 2018 Municipal Utility Board Needs Assessment Budget which included a \$750,000.00 transfer to the City of Pryor Creek and a projected Net Income of \$78,360.00. Mr. Jared Crisp added, the Budget also included \$260,000.00 for some equipment replacements and Capital Improvements for some of our facilities, contingent on funds being available and prioritized need.

A motion was made by Dr. Lindsey and seconded by Mr. Roberts to approve the 2018 Municipal Utility Board Needs Assessment Budget for Fiscal Year Ending 30 June 2018; which included a \$750,000.00 transfer to the City of Pryor Creek, \$260,000.00 for some equipment replacements and Capital Improvements for some of our facilities, and a projected Net Income of \$78,360.00. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Lindsey, Roberts, Sixkiller, Mitchell, and Harris Nay – none

Mr. Pruett discussed and recommended the approval of the engagement letter to perform the Municipal Utility Board Annual Audit for Fiscal Year Ending 30 June 2017 from Ms. Violet Kirkendall with Hood & Associates CPA's PC at a cost not to exceed \$4,250 (the same price as last year).

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to authorize Ms. Violet Kirkendall with Hood & Associates

CPA's PC to perform the Municipal Utility Board Annual Audit for Fiscal Year Ending 30 June 2017 at a cost not to exceed \$4,250 (the same price as last year). MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Roberts, Mitchell, Lindsey, Sixkiller, and Harris Nay – none

There was no unfinished or new business discussed.

A motion was made by Dr. Sixkiller and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to adjourn this meeting at 5:11PM. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Sixkiller, Mitchell, Lindsey, Roberts, and Harris Nay – none
