

April 5, 2021

The Municipal Utility Board met in a Regular Session at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, April 5, 2021, with Chairman Harris presiding. The agenda was posted in the outside Pryor City Hall Bulletin Case at 12 North Rowe Street. Members present were: Mr. Garry Harris, Mr. Mark Roberts, and Dr. Art Sixkiller, Dr. Ken Rains, and Ms. Lorri Mitchell.

Guests attending were Mr. Terry Aylward and Mr. Travis Willis.

A motion was made by Dr. Rains and seconded by Mr. Roberts to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting held March 15, 2021. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes - Rains, Roberts, Sixkiller, Mitchell, and Harris Nay - none

A motion was made by Dr. Sixkiller and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to approve Claims #985 - #1062 totaling \$525,241.25 for payment. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes - Sixkiller, Mitchell, Roberts, Rains, and Harris Nay - none

Honorable Mayor Lees was not present.

The Board recognized Mr. Steve Powell who reported he was ready to schedule a pre-work meeting for the construction of the Proposed Sanitary Sewer Interceptor Extension (Giles Sewer). Mr. Jared Crisp was available for the pre-work meeting on Thursday (April 8, 2021) or Monday or Tuesday (April 12 or 13, 2021).

Mr. Powell reported on the City of Pryor Creek Storm Drainage Projects at NE 3rd Street and Eastmanor Circle and at SE 14th Street and South Fairland Street. Mr. Powell reported the 14th Street and South Fairland Storm Drainage Project had been delayed until he could review the discovery that would impact the sewer main with Municipal Utility Board Staff.

The Board recognized Mr. Jared Crisp who conceded to Mr. Travis Willis who discussed the traffic signal at the intersection of US69 Highway and SE 9th Street. He also discussed the proposed agreement with Traffic Signals Inc. to rewire the traffic signal at the intersection of US69 Highway and SE 9th Street.

Mr. Crisp recommended the Board enter into an agreement with Traffic Signals Inc. to rewire the traffic signal at the intersection of US69 Highway and SE 9th Street at a cost not to exceed \$9,470.00. Mr. Crisp reported he sent a request to share the cost of this agreement to the Honorable Mayor Lees of the City of Pryor Creek.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts and seconded by Dr. Rains to enter into an agreement with Traffic Signals Inc. to rewire the traffic signal at the intersection of US69 Highway and SE 9th Street at a cost not to exceed \$9,470.00. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes -Roberts, Rains, Sixkiller, Mitchell, and Harris Nay - none

Mr. Crisp discussed the revisions of the General Employment Policies of the Pryor Municipal Utility Board which included clarification of employee benefits, added the gas department to the FR (fire-retardant) clothing allowance and FR requirements, and clarified the standard safety glasses to be provided by the Municipal Utility Board.

A motion was made by Dr. Sixkiller and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to approve the recommended revisions of the General Employment Policies of the Pryor Municipal Utility Board. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Sixkiller, Mitchell, Roberts, Rains, and Harris Nay – none

Mr. Crisp reported he prepared Easements for the Roosevelt Crossing Project at the request of Ms. Harriet Dunham.

Mr. Steve Powell reported on an easement issue which could affect the electric extension and upgrade in the Eastmanor Additions.

The Board recognized Mrs. Teri Hill who had no report.

A written Department Foreman's Report was presented with no additional comments.

Mr. Crisp discussed and recommended the Board replace the 2011 New Holland Workmaster 45 2WD Rops Tractor w/Rhino 172 6' Rotary Cutter (Unit #37) with a John Deere 5055E Utility Tractor with a John Deere 520M Loader and a John Deere MX6 Lift-Type Rotary Cutter — 540 RPM PTO at a cost not to exceed the State Central Purchasing Contract Price of \$40,352.96 from P & K Equipment in Pryor, Oklahoma. Mr. Crisp also reported the 2011 New Holland Tractor would not be declared surplus but rather used in the drying beds at the treatment plant.

A motion was made by Dr. Rains and seconded by Mr. Roberts to replace the 2011 New Holland Workmaster 45 2WD Rops Tractor w/Rhino 172 6' Rotary Cutter (Unit #37) with a John Deere 5055E Utility Tractor with a John Deere 520M Loader and a John Deere MX6 Lift-Type Rotary Cutter – 540 RPM PTO at a cost not to exceed the State Central Purchasing Contract Price of \$40,352.96 from P & K Equipment in Pryor, Oklahoma. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Rains, Roberts, Mitchell, Sixkiller, and Harris Nay – none

Mr. Crisp discussed and recommended the Board replace the 2015 John Deere PR 15 Gator TS (Unit 39) with a 2021 John Deere 592AM Gator XUV590M at a cost not to exceed the State Central Purchasing Contract Price of \$11,636.25 from P & K Equipment in Pryor, Oklahoma. If approved the 2015 John Deere PR 15 Gator TS would be transferred to the Warehouse for use by all departments.

A motion was made by Dr. Sixkiller and seconded by Dr. Rains to replace the 2015 John Deere PR 15 Gator TS (Unit 39) with a 2021 John Deere 592AM Gator XUV590M at a cost not to exceed the State Central Purchasing Contract Price of \$11,636.25 from P & K Equipment in Pryor, Oklahoma.
